PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to contribute to a framework for creating safe and supportive school environments throughout Catholic Schools Broken Bay (CSBB). This policy identifies the responses to be taken by CSBB in addressing concerns about possible abuse or neglect of children and young people. The Policy identifies the need to:

Recognise the role of reporting risk of significant harm to the Department of Communities and Justice (DCJ) as an important strategy for promoting the protection of children and young people.

Understand the importance of providing support to children and young people at risk in accordance with the Pastoral Care & Student Wellbeing Policy.

Ensure that the legal and general duty of care in relation to exchanging information
